GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION

- *All participants must register for each activity. Students, who do not complete the registration process, including payment, where applicable, will not be permitted to participate in the activity.
- *Students of all ages who are waiting for their activity to begin or for transportation after their activity has ended are expected to remain in their assigned area (in the library, or in the North Car Park). This is to ensure that students are in an environment that is monitored. Please set the expectation with your child to remain in their area and encourage your child to make productive use of the waiting time.
- *Parents are expected to make arrangements to pick up their child no later than 15 minutes after the end of the activity, unless the child must wait for a sibling to finish a different activity.
- *Students are expected to conduct themselves properly during after school activities and when moving through the building after regular school hours, including following the directions of teachers and instructors and adhering to normal school rules.
- *Parents of Students who are not taking part in the ASA program must make arrangements to pick up their child no later than 15 minutes after school is dismissed.

IMPORTANT GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Registration Period is Monday 19th March - Friday 13th April 2012. Classes with limited space are on a first come, first served basis.
2. "NC" indicates an activity that is free of charge.
3. Return registration forms and payment to the Front Desk.
4. Please make payments using checks or Linx only. Make checks payable to "ISPS".
5. Additional registration forms are available at the front desk of the school.
6. Complete one form per child.
7. Refunds will not be made after the second week of activities.
8. Each activity must have a minimum number of participants. The number varies among classes. Any student who registers for a class that does not reach the minimum may select another class or receive a refund.
9. Every effort will be made to contact parents as early as possible if an activity must be cancelled on a particular day. Please ensure that contact numbers given are accurate.
10. Parents are asked to pick up students after classes.
11. Parents should not attend classes as there is the tendency to distract the students (especially in Gymnastics and Karate classes)

ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS

Arts and Craft- ES students are given the opportunity to express themselves creatively in a variety of artistic ways.

Badminton- Middle and High School students learn the skills of this very fast paced game.

Basketball-Elementary school boys and girls will learn practice skills and rules of the game.

Chess - Students learn skills and play matches with each other and in local competitions.

Dance Group - Learn Modern/Jazz routines, Sequence dancing and more. The Group will prepare routines for various ISPS events and any relevant external competitions.

Drama - All age level of students will have fun while developing expressive and creative skills via role-playing, script writing, and learning acting techniques.

Gymnastics - Students learn the basics of tumbling and non-apparatus gymnastics. LL students will be registered with the National Association (\$50.00)

Karate - Students learn the basics of Shotokan Karate and have the opportunity to grade (move up in rank) every three months and participate in community tournaments.

Modern Dance - Learn the movements of the modern dance world. Create routines for your own enjoyment and for performance.

Steel Pan- Learn the Musical instrument of Trinidad and Tobago with qualified instructors. Only 15 students will be in the class.

ISPS Pan Ensemble- Intermediate Level. (No more than 20 players)

This is a performance group.

Soccer- Learn the basic skill of the world's favorite sport in an environment that is geared for the students' enjoyment.

Spanish Club - Spanish Club holds meetings twice a month, every other Friday of each month. Students of High School foster a greater understanding of the Spanish culture and language.
