

# -AP World History-

The AP course in World History examines the major transitions & developments that have formed the world in which we live and teaches students key skills in analysis, interpretation & evaluation when faced with a variety of different forms of evidence. Students will focus on five distinct time periods:

- Foundations; circa 8000 B.C.E. ~ 600 C.E.
  - 600 C.E. ~ 1450
  - 1450 ~ 1750
  - 1750 ~ 1914
  - 1914 - Present

The designated text for this course is *The Earth & Its Peoples*.
