Month	Content	Skills
August/September	General revision	Conjugating verbs; Counting; Spelling; Telling time; Booking tables or rooms; Answering phone; Expressing feelings; Telling of experiences
October	Opinion	Expression of one's taste and opinion; Expression of judgment; Comparing; Expressing surprise.
November/December	Responsibility	Telling someone what to do; Advising; Telling about rules and regulations; Differentiating speech standards; Answering complaint; Explaining problem; convincing; Writing letters; Telling of scheme or project; Congratulating.
December	Revision	Responsibility continued
January	Negotiating	Proposing; Accepting or refusing; taking and justifying decision; Reporting; Identifying the sources of information; Summarizing.
February	Certainty	Expressing certainty; Changing the subject of a conversation; Ending a conversation and leave; Criticizing someone; Toasting someone; Expressing regrets.
March	Argumentation	Establishing relation between cause and effect; Formulating hypothesis; Organizing one's speech. Essay writing.
April	Worry	Expressing concerns about someone opinion; Expressing concerns; Making a favor to someone
May	Textual Analysis	Recognizing different type of Texts; Outlining ideas of texts; Giving a definition; Summarizing a text.
June	Revision Final Examination	Revision
