August/September	Opinion	Interrupting a conversation; Laying blame; Expressing wishes; Reassuring someone. Reviewing the use of tenses in indicative Mood
October	Service offering	Asking or Proposing help/service; Refusing or accepting an invitation; Expressing doubts and wishes; Introduction to French Subjunctive Mood and formation of adverbs in -ment; writing an official letter.
November	Suggestion	Suggesting; Making hypothesis; Using conditional Mood; Writing an official letter;
December	Certainty	Expressing certainty; criticising; direct /indirect speech; the use of gerund and of the present participle; Writing a letter of complaint.
January	Encouragement	Showing an interest in someone/something Congratulating the author and highlighting his/her action/works. The use of indirect speech in interrogative form The use of the passive form. Writing a letter to a friend.
February	Regrets	Expressing regrets; Making suppositions in the past tenses. The use of the pluperfect in indirect speech. The use of the past infinitive Narrative writing .
March	Indignation	Expressing indignation or annoyance about, at; Making projects. Expressing facts in future perfect tense; the use of pronouns en/y; Narrative writing; Narrative writing and the use of devoir, pouvoir, vouloir
April	Worry and astonishment	Expressing concerns about someone's opinion; expression a fact in a future perfect tense Descriptive writing ; use of C'est...qui; C'est...que; faire + infinitive (causatif)
May	Opposition/Concession	Expressing opposition/Concession;
June	Revision/ Examination	Revision
