French 4 is the advanced intermediate level course. The approach is thematic or topical. A number of themes and topics relevant to their age group are appropriately chosen and explored or studied. It focuses on the acquisition of more fluency and comfort in the usage of the language by studying the following skills: story telling; reporting; summarizing; fiche de lecture writing and textual and literary analysis. These concur to prepare students to communicate critically and for those who are willing to further their French studies at the advanced placement level to do so with less stress.
