Video Production

Video production is a one year course with two major requirements. In the first semester students are expected to produce a three to five minute individual project and in the second semester students are allocated specific productions tasks based on interest, and are required to produce a thirty minute group project. They learn how to develop a treatment for their concept, a script outline, a screen play, a story board, a shot list and a shooting schedule. In post production they learn how log their shots for continuity and finally the editing process, using the Mac Intosh G5 i-movie editing program.

Leadership

Leadership prepares students to handle conflicts and resolutions while developing strong group dynamics and social skills. At the end of the course students have a greater understanding of setting and achieving goals through self-based and community projects. Students are expected throughout the year to participate in community service through the ISPS radio program in school as well as outreach programs in selected communities.

Theatre Arts

Theatre Arts is a one year course which exposes the young actor to elements of stage and screen acting. This year students will learn the basics of stage acting in preparation for the end of year high school production and learn acting for screen through workshops in acting for commercials and television programming.
